Application Deadline March 15

The application of a pre-proposal must meet the following guidelines:

1. Application must be submitted by a faculty member for an identified student or a student to be named.
2. Include a descriptive title.
3. Include an abstract of no more than 100 words.
4. Include a brief description of the proposed training program (no more than two typewritten pages).
5. Include a brief description of the proposed project (no more than two typewritten pages), including methods used for evaluation of student performance and progress and a plan for dissemination of relevant knowledge during and after performance of project.
6. Include bibliography citing relevant source materials.
7. Provide a two-page curriculum vitae for the faculty sponsor.
8. Provide a brief description of your organization and the facilities available for this project.
9. Print this form and provide a completed copy with your application package.
